CECE moves to new home at the Virginia Tech Corporate Research Center

The Center for Economic and Community Engagement moved into their new office on 1900 Kraft Drive at the Virginia Tech Corporate Research Center, a little more than a year after their move from their previous office at 702 University Blvd.



Blair Durham receives Virginia Tech Influential Black Alumni Award

Alumna Blair Durham, the president and co-founder of Black BRAND, a Hampton Roads nonprofit that works to increase Black wealth in the region by promoting professional development and community empowerment, was among nine Hokies honored this month with Virginia Tech Influential Black Alumni Awards. Durham, who holds a degree from the College of Science, sits on the Center for Economic and Community Engagement advisory board.

She is the recipient of the Social Justice Award, which recognizes an alum who seeks to increase fairness and equity for those systematically disenfranchised and least served politically, economically, or socially.

In 2021 and 2022, Durham worked with Mallory Tuttle, associate director of the Newport News Center, and Afroze Mohammed, associate director of strategic alliances for CECE, as well as computational modeling and data analytics students, to develop a data dashboard that shows "the state of the Black community in the Hampton Roads region" and enables Black BRAND to better understand the factors that affect the economic and social progress of Black residents in the area.
