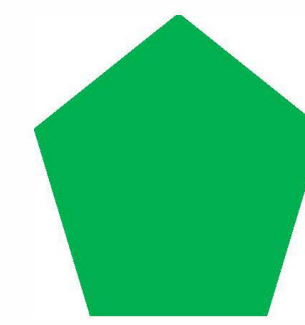

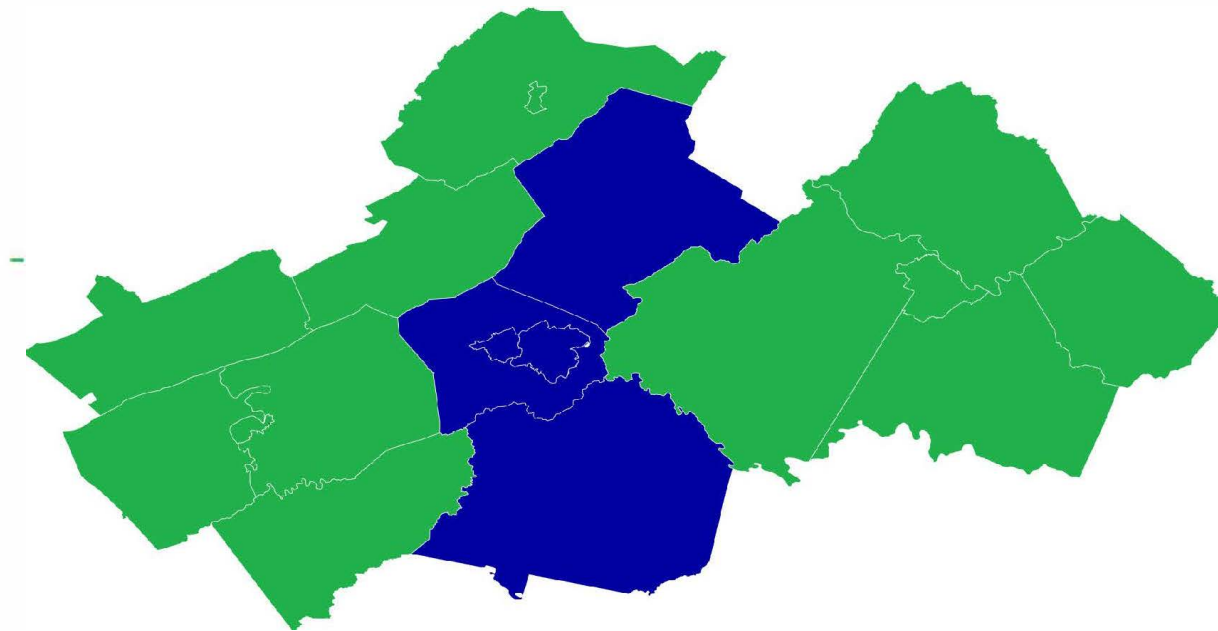

Wood Haven Road Water and Sewer Infrastructure Enhancement

Attracting businesses to Region 2 through extension of water and sewer facilities, and a Tier 4 Business Ready Site Certification.

The project seeks to attract new businesses to the region through site preparedness by improving site readiness and marketability. Prior to receiving funds, the site was unable to be developed and did not attract businesses to the area. Through the project, water and sewer utility connections to the site will be made ready for use, and these improvements will propel the site to a Tier 4 readiness standard through the Virginia Businesses Ready Sites Program.
